The only difference between homework assignments, and tests and quizzes, is that **quizzes and tests will be timed, the "help" tabs will not be there, and there will be only 2 attempts for quizzes and 1 attempt for a test.** You should have plenty of time.

Please pay close attention to the due dates.

For homework, you might be using the tabs in Aleks. The following tabs are there to help you;

"Guided Solution" ,which you have been using,

"Show Example" ,which is quite good,

"Link to Textbook" ,to look at other examples in the text.

Definitely feel free to use "Ask my Instructor".

I will be available on-line during my office hours, Tuesdays & Thursdays from 10:00am -11:00am and by appointment. These sessions are NOT mandatory.

This will be done using "Zoom". You can download the free app to your computer, tablet or phone. I will schedule a meeting at those times and all you need to do is "join meeting". I will send you the appropriate link with meeting ID and password through the email function in Aleks.
